## Notification no. 53/2017

Sub: Revised Process Timelines for DDU-GKY Project commencement after PAC / EC Approval - reg.

It is hereby stated that the Ministry has observed that projects which have not been able to commence training within the stipulated time, and/or, have also been unable to start training in sufficient batches to cover their first year targets, have found it difficult to achieve E2 certificate (i.e. certification on achievement of milestones for release of second installment). This has invariably delayed PIAs to obtain installments in a timely manner apart from impacting the project outcomes. This issue was discussed with stakeholders, State Governments, CTSA and PIAs, and after review of the SOP provisions, a general consensus emerged that with greater maturity in the DDU-GKY eco-system, the time lines for project commencement post-PAC approval may be reduced.

2. Notwithstanding provisions in the SOP, it is stated that the following time lines shall be applicable for "Inception phase" (as given in Table 1-2 "Timeline of major events" under Section 1.4):

3. The above shall not exempt a PIA from compliance with the provisions of clause (d) in section 3.1.1.1regarding minimum trainings to be initiated in a year as per project duration.

4. Where a PIA is unable to commence a project/achieve the desired batch strength within the stipulated time as above, competent authority may levy a penalty. Details on penalty to be imposed shall be notified separately by Ministry.

5. The notification shall be applicable with immediate effect on all new approved projects. Provided that where a project has completed a major event as per schedule given above, the timelines applicable for further remaining events in the schedule shall be applicable.

6. This notification issues with the approval of Competent Authority and comes into force with immediate effect
